

## Nursery Rainbow Challenges

Dear Parents,

This week in Nursery we have introduced our 'Rainbow Challenges'. Each child has their own pocket to collect their coloured sticks in. The target is to collect all 7 different coloured lolly sticks by Friday. They do this by completing a range of activities set around Nursery each week. The activities will be based in both the indoor and outdoor classrooms and will cover all the different areas of the Nursery curriculum. All children that complete all 7 challenges will receive a special reward certificate and sticker, in our Early Years Achievement Assembly held on Friday afternoon (or presented to them in Nursery, if they don't attend on a Friday afternoon).

We would really like you to support us in encouraging your child to complete their 7 challenges. On Monday, you could ask your child about the first set of challenges they've been given that week (we usually introduce 4 on a Monday and 3 on a Wednesday). During the week you could ask about which ones they have completed or which ones still need to be completed. On Friday you could give them a final reminder that that is their last day to try and finish any challenges they've not done. At any drop off or pick up times you could take your child to their rainbow and look at the sticks they have achieved.

In previous years, our 'Rainbow Challenge' system has been extremely successful, especially in cases where parents have been involved. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to speak to the Nursery staff.
