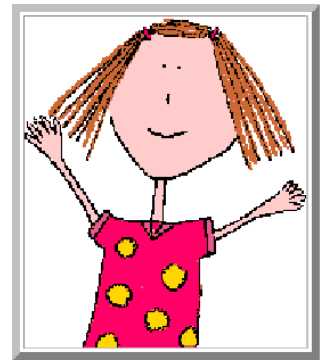

- Matching correct numeral to groups of objects to 10
