




Literacy

Mathematics



- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10's
- Counting, reading and writing numbers to 100
- Number bonds to 10 and 20 and inverse operations
- Finding half and quarters of objects and shapes
- Estimating, measuring, weighing and comparing objects.
- Understanding time.—o'clock/ half past
- Doubling and halving
- Solving puzzles and problems.



Science

Animals including humans


