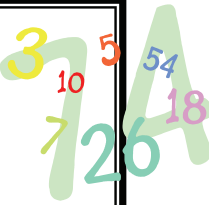

French lessons will involve speaking and listening and developing understanding of the French culture.



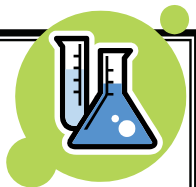

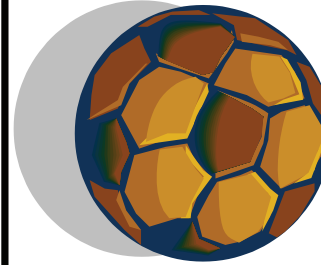

- No earrings to be worn in either P.E. or Games

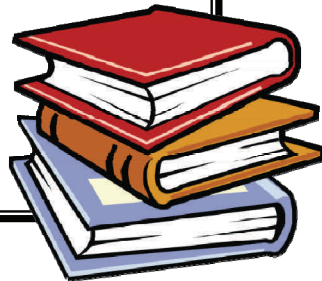


Homework

- Please change reading book at least once a week.

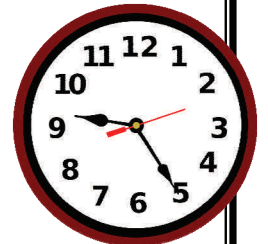


Year 3 Additional Information
