Walk to school month

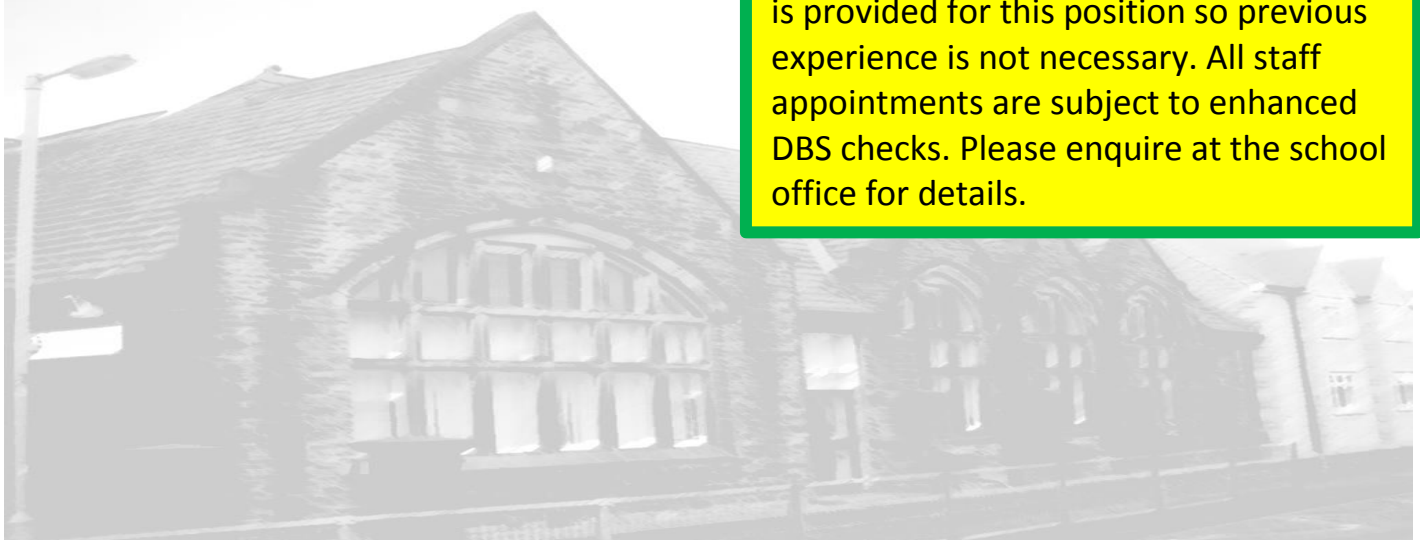
